## PLAYER INFORMATION SHEET

*Welcome To the 2010 Soccer Season!*

The following is a brief outline of procedures for new players and a reminder for those who have played with us before.

**Pre-Season Games:-**The Club will arrange pre-season games with other local soccer clubs. These games will take place in March at a time and place yet to be nominated on a Saturday or Sunday. Correct gear is to be worn at these games. Please arrive at least 30 min. before the appointed time for your match.

**Clothing:-**The Club provides a soccer shirt which remains the property of the club. You must provide a pair of soccer boots and shin pads - the 'under the foot type' is recommended, (if you do not provide shin pads, he/she will not be able to play). **Training:-**E.L.S. Hall Sports Ground, No.2 field in Kent Road is the ground that the Club hires for training on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. You will be notified by your coach or a club official of your first training session. You must wear your shin pads.

**Code of Conduct:-**Playing for our club is subject to adhering to our code of conduct as well as the Gladesville Hornsby Football Association's code of conduct.

**Communication:-**There are four main ways of receiving information within the Club.

☎ By contacting your coach or manager, or other official of the club. A list of committee members and their contact numbers is on the web.

☎ By telephone. The Club recommends that each team Manager produce a circular with names, addresses, telephone numbers and e-mail addresses. When information is required to be given to all interested parties a chain of calls can be initiated. This saves one person from having to make all the calls.

**Canteen:-**On Saturday mornings the canteen at E.L.S. Hall will be open at 8.00am. The canteen sells sweets, hot & cold drinks, and hot food.
